## CBS Sports Reaches Multi-Year Agreement to Air Big East Games Through 2024-2025 Season

CBS and CBS Sports Network to Televise 20 Men's Regular-Season Basketball Games per Year Through Sublicense Agreement with FOX Sports

CBS Sports and the Big East Conference have reached a new multi-year agreement to televise Big East men's college basketball games on the CBS Television Network and CBS Sports Network. The deal, which runs through the 2024-2025 season, is through a sublicense agreement with FOX Sports.

The agreement provides national exposure for 20 men's regular-season basketball games per year, with at least two appearances for each of the 10 schools. CBS Sports will broadcast up to four games per season with the remainder airing on CBS Sports Network.

"CBS Sports has partnered with the Big East for more than 35 years, and we are thrilled to be able to continue to showcase the conference across our platforms for years to come," said Dan Weinberg, Executive Vice President, Programming, CBS Sports.
